## Project transnational staff training in Greece

Last April, representatives from partners' organisations had the opportunity to visit IASIS's Sheltered House for migrants and asylum seekers families in the Athens. In this study visit they explored the structure and its particularities, met staff and beneficiaries, and they had the chance to discuss with their training needs and pros/ cons in their everyday working routine. Other aspects such as legislation and internal regulation were also discussed and different cultural issues reflected.



## Lighthouse project in Austria: "jobwerkstatt"

Last March, the international team member of the Lighthouse project visited the local project "jobwerkstatt" in Vienna (Austria), financed by the Public Employment Service Austria (AMS) and carried out by BEST applying the structure of the Lighthouse Model and its four zones.

The participants can join the programme every working day with an initial information event. In a personal counselling the current situation of the unemployed is assessed and an individual workshop plan for the following five weeks defined. The key part of the project consists of a variety of around 90 different workshops. During this period the participants have the additional attendance of their personal counsellors and business contact persons and access to the so called application-zone where they find up-to-date job advertisements and individual support for their application.

During the guided tour through the project manager Mag. Paul Gschwandtner gave some detailed overview about the individual path of clients and the practical impact and success factors.
