



Lighthouse Guidebook is now available

The Lighthouse Guidebook “innovative strategies and techniques in career guidance and counselling for migrants”, is a comprehensive resource providing in depth information on the theoretical foundations of the Lighthouse model and its innovative strategies and techniques for career guidance and counselling for migrants. The first part of the Guidebook contains:

- An approximation on the theoretical foundations of the Lighthouse model
- A contextual analyse of the situation, problems and needs of the migrant people with regard to their career development process
- Description of the organizational and professional frameworks of the career services for migrants: context, challenges and problems to face and limits of the usual approaches and methods applied
- Lighthouse innovative strategies and techniques for career guidance and counselling: self-directed learning concept, empowerment, community integration, intercultural conflict mediation, and social coaching

The second part of the Guidebook contains a presentation of the tools and methods developed for the Lighthouse Toolbox. This presentation will serve as a guide for those counselling and career guidance professionals interested on applying Lighthouse model in their organizations.

Lighthouse Toolbox is ready for professionals

The Lighthouse Toolbox “innovative methods and implementation models in career guidance and counselling for migrants”, is a resource that contains practical information for the implementation of innovative methods in career services for migrants, following the Lighthouse interactive model.



The Toolbox contains a set of 26 practical tools and methods adapted to the specific needs of the target beneficiaries, the migrant people, and to the target users: counsellors, educators, trainers, managers and other professionals working at career guidance and counselling services for migrants.

This collection of innovative methods and tools is related with the four dimensions of the Lighthouse model: Recognition, Training, Employment and Mobility. Furthermore, these tools and methods forms the necessary pathway to be followed by those counselling and career guidance organizations and professionals interested in the implementation of the Lighthouse interactive model. The Toolbox can be used as a checklist to, step by step and within each area of the model, guide the process for the implementation of the Lighthouse innovative solution for supporting lifelong learning and career paths for migrants.

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Project transnational meeting in Cyprus

The fifth transnational meeting of Lighthouse Project was held in Nicosia, Cyprus, in October 2016. Partners’ organisations have shared the main achievements regarding the project outputs, such as the Guidebook and Toolbox afore mentioned. Furthermore, partners agreed on the next steps for the development of other project outputs:

Guidelines for the implementation of Lighthouse innovative methods for career guidance for migrants; and the Lighthouse Didactic Films, An attractive pedagogical tool for more lively training. Besides this, the partnership have established a common methodology for carrying out the piloting phase to test the Lighthouse model in each participant country.

Next steps: piloting phase and multiplier events

During the next months of the project lifecycle, partners are going to carry out the piloting phase in each participant country to test the Lighthouse methodology and tools among their potential users and beneficiaries. The pilots will imply: a capacity building for the staff of those organizations involved in the pilots, the identification and registration of the participant migrants, the implementation of the Lighthouse methodology, and the assessment of the process among all participants. Furthermore, partners are going to carry out the necessary steps for the preparation of the national multiplier events in each participant country, and the final international conference to be held in Madrid Spain in June 2017.



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
